AMA WATERWAYS - ROMANTIC DANUBE ITINERARY

Day 1

Vilshofen, Germany

Board the Ama Sonata for your Romantic Danube cruise. Later in the day, attend an exclusive Oktoberfest celebration with traditional beer and Bavarian folk music and dancing. (D)

Day 2

Vilshofen – Passau, Germany

Explore Vilshofen's beautiful old town before cruising to Passau, known as the "City of Three Rivers". Join a walking tour or if you prefer to be more active, hike high into the hills for a visit to the "Veste Oberhaus", Passau's Castle Hill; or go on a River Inn bike tour. (B, L, D)

Day 3

Linz, Austria

Arrive in Linz where you'll have several excursion choices: a full-day excursion to Salzburg where you'll tour the historic center, Mirabell Gardens, Residenz Square and the Old Market. En route to Salzburg, stop at Mondsee, home of the famed Basilica St. Michael and site of the wedding scene in The Sound of Music; or join a full-day excursion to the charming Czech mountain town of Cesky Krumlov, where you can stroll its cobblestone streets; marvel at the city's picturesque Baroque and Renaissance-style building; and tour Krumlov Castle, one of Europe's largest castle complexes. Following these full-day excursions, you may also choose to take a walking tour in Linz. Alternatively, join a walking tour through the old city center of Linz and by the Mozart House, or bike along the city's famed "Cultural Mile" and the Danube. (B, L, D)

Day 4

Weissenkirchen, Austria

Head up to the Sun Deck for panoramic views as you unwind with a scenic cruise through the Strudengau and UNESCO-designated Wachau Valley. In Weissenkirchen, you'll be treated to several choices of excursions. Take a walking tour of Durnstein then visit the UNESCO - designated Melk Abbey or hike up to the ruins of Durnstein Fortress, where Richard the Lionheart was once held captive, and enjoy spectacular views of the river valley and village below. You can also choose to cycle through the Wachau wine region from a local boutique. (B, L, D)

Day 5

Vienna, Austria

The "City of Waltzes" offers a treasure trove of gems, and a city tour showcases them, including the majestic Opera House and former Imperial Palace. Your tour concludes in the historic city center with a visit to St. Stephen's Cathedral. Or if you prefer a more active tour, take a guided bike ride through Vienna. During the afternoon, enjoy leisure time to further explore this iconic city. (B, L, D)

Day 6

Bratislava, Slovakia

Host to the crowning ceremonies of 11 Hungarian kings and queens between 1536 and 1830, Bratislava is referred to as the "Coronation City of Kings", as you'll discover during your walking tour. Or join a "Tastes of Slovakia" tour. For a more active adventure, hike up to Bratislava Castle, offering magnificent views of the city. (B, L, D)

Day 7

Budapest, Hungary

Today visit both the Buda (hilly) and Pest (flat) sides of the Danube River. Start on the Buda side, following your guide through the city's Castle District where you will marvel at the fairytale turrets of Fisherman's Bastion, gaze upon the breathtaking panorama below and see Matthias Church, renowned for its striking tower and colorful mosaic roof. For a more active tour, hike to Budapest's Castle Hill. In the afternoon, explore the treasures of Pest, admiring the colossal Hungarian Parliament Building, Heroes' Square and the moving "Shoes on the Danube Bank" memorial. (B, L, D)

Day 8

Budapest, Hungary

Disembark the ship as you prepare for your flights home, taking with you all your wonderful memories. (B)
